**BYLAW NO. 01-08  
A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN  
AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH A  
MUTUAL AID AREA**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the councils of:

Town of St. Walburg	, and
Town of Turtleford	, and
Village of Paradise Hill	, and
Village of Vawn	, and
Village of Mervin	, and
Village of Edam	, and
Village of Spruce Lake	, and
R.M. of Turtle River No. 469	, and
R.M. of Mervin No. 499	, and
Resort Village of Kivimaa - Moonlight Bay	, and
Brightsand Lake Regional Park Authority	

The terms of which are attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".

2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit "A" herebefore referred to.
3. Bylaw No. 98-01 is hereby repealed.

## EXHIBIT "A"

THIS AGREEMENT, consisting of twelve copies, effective the 1st day of January, 2002.

**BETWEEN:**

WHEREAS the municipalities above mentioned deem it expedient to enter into an agreement to establish a mutual aid area pursuant to section 11 of The Emergency Planning Act, and to develop a plan to deal with emergencies occurring within the said municipalities:

**NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the parties to this agreement form a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization.
2. That each party to the agreement will assist any other party to the agreement in the event of an emergency or disaster.
3. That each member municipality shall appoint two people to represent the municipality, However, each member municipality shall be allowed only one vote.
4. That the appointed representatives shall act as the Advisory Control Committee who shall annually:
  - a) elect from the Advisory Control Committee, one person to act as Chairman;
  - b) appoint a recording secretary for the purpose of recording minutes and circulating correspondence;
  - c) appoint a mutually agreed upon Mutual Aid Area E.M.O. Co-ordinator.
5. That the Advisory Control Committee shall determine the location of the Emergency Response Centre Headquarters.
6. That the objectives of the Mutual Aid Area are as follows:
  - a) to establish a unified, effective organization involving neighbouring communities to lend reciprocal assistance, expertise, equipment and manpower services in a declared emergency or needed situation.

- b) to provide an effective program of communications to ensure a co-ordinated response to any emergency within the Mutual Aid Area.
- c) to acquire and maintain a current list of manpower and equipment available in each municipality.
- d) to develop a Mutual Aid Area plan to effectively use the resources of manpower and equipment available throughout the area.
- e) to prepare the necessary documentation to be submitted to the responsible bodies in the attainment of material, funding, training, or consultive services for the betterment of the program.

7. That each party to this agreement agrees to pay the annual membership fee as follows:

Membership fee of \$200.00 for a population over 250  
 Membership fee of \$100.00 for a population under 249

8. That each party to this agreement recognizes that there is no financial commitment, other than the annual membership fee, unless they decide otherwise.

9. That this agreement shall be continuous; however, any party to the agreement may withdraw from the agreement by giving each other party to the agreement (60) days written notice of such withdrawal.

10. In this agreement "municipality" means rural and urban municipalities and regional park authorities.
