

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501

BYLAW NO. 08/01

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501 TO REGULATE THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM, AND THE USE OF THE SEWAGE SYSTEM IN THE HAMLET OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED THEREOF.**

WHEREAS the Council may regulate the distribution and use of the water and sewer system in the Hamlet of Frenchman Butte and may fix the prices for the use thereof and the time of payments.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. All persons desiring to be supplied with water from the Hamlet's water supply system shall make application to the administrative office of the Municipality. Each application shall be accompanied by the payment of a hook-up fee in the amount of \$20.00 plus a refundable meter deposit in the sum of \$75.00 prior to connection.
2. The Municipality shall have the right to ration or limit the amount of water furnished to any and/or all consumers should circumstances seem to warrant such action.
3. A charge of \$10.00 shall be made for shutting off the water service and a charge of \$10.00 shall be made for subsequently turning on the water service.
4. If the water supply is shut off to the premises of a user for infringement of the provisions of this bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees and arrears, if any, have been paid in full and will be subject to a \$40.00 reconnection fee.
5. All sites with a structures shall be assessed an annual fee in the amount of \$150.00 per year to be set aside for future capital expenditures.
6. The following annual rates shall apply for the internal use of well water:

a) Households/Commercial	\$ 440.00 per year
b) Hotels and Restaurants	\$ 825.00 per year
c) Post Office	\$ 55.00 per year
d) Seniors Club Room	\$ 165.00 per year
7. Any property using the well water for watering outside vegetation shall be assessed an additional annual rate of \$ 300.00.
8. All properties serviced by the sewer system shall be assessed an annual rate of \$ 120.00 per year.
9. All rates, costs or charges made under the authority of this bylaw that remains unpaid at the end of the year in which the service was provided, may be added to the taxes on the property and collected in the same manner as taxes.
10. Bylaw 06-03 is hereby repealed.

The rates or charges contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.
