BYLAW NO. 08/02

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SANITATION FEE, FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE FROM DWELLINGS AND OTHER BUILDINGS LOCATED WITHIN THE ORGANIZED HAMLET OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Sanitation service, consisting of weekly pickup of household garbage, will be provided to the residents of the organized Hamlet of Frenchman Butte.
2. A fee of \$ 75.00 will be assessed each year for each dwelling or other building, including a trailer that will have the benefit of the sanitation service with the exception of the Senior Club Room which will be charged at one-half of the regular rate.
3. Any amount assessed, that remains unpaid at the end of the year in which the service was provided, may be added to the taxes on the property and collected in the same manner as taxes.
4. Bylaw 06-04 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw shall come into effect on July 1, 2008.

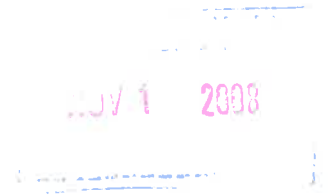

Enclosed for your records is approval of water and sewer utility rates pursuant to Section 23(3) of *The Municipalities Act*.


In establishing sewer rates the committee would suggest the following factors be considered:

- i) The rates should be equitable. This does not necessarily mean equal.
- ii) The rates should consider impact and demand on the system. An example of impact would be whether a certain type of consumer places contaminants in the sewer that require special chemicals and therefore, increase costs. Demand on the system is more closely related to the amount of sewage placed into the system.

The committee would appreciate receiving the rationale to support the sewer rate when the rural municipality submits its' next utility bylaw for approval.

The water rate policy should be amended to reflect the changes in the bylaw. Please provide a copy of the updated water rate policy when it is available.

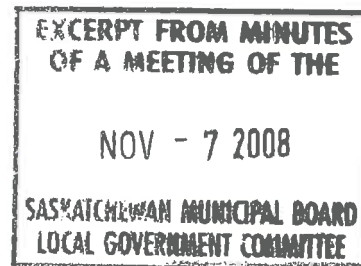


Approval: R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501
