BYLAW NO 2013-27

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the [full name of municipality].
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services, including fire prevention and fire suppression, provided by the municipality shall be levied, at the discretion of council:
 - a) throughout the municipality;
 - b) in part throughout the municipality, or in any specified area of the municipality, and in part to persons who receive the service; or
 - c) directly on persons who receive the service.
- 3. For the purpose of assessing and levying costs of fire fighting services, the person who owns or occupies the land upon which a fire originated shall be deemed to be a person who receives the fire fighting services to control and extinguish the fire.
- 4. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any land, improvement or business owned by the person referenced in Section 2 and Section 3 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
- 5. Sections 6, 7 and 8 of Bylaw No. 98-05 are hereby rescinded.
