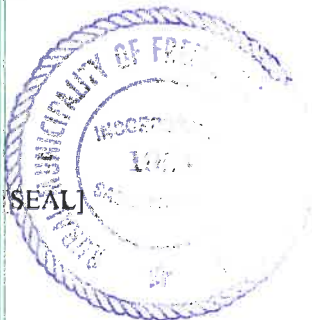


BYLAW NO 2013-27

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the [full name of municipality].
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services, including fire prevention and fire suppression, provided by the municipality shall be levied, at the discretion of council:
 - a) throughout the municipality;
 - b) in part throughout the municipality, or in any specified area of the municipality, and in part to persons who receive the service; or
 - c) directly on persons who receive the service.
3. For the purpose of assessing and levying costs of fire fighting services, the person who owns or occupies the land upon which a fire originated shall be deemed to be a person who receives the fire fighting services to control and extinguish the fire.
4. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any land, improvement or business owned by the person referenced in Section 2 and Section 3 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
5. Sections 6, 7 and 8 of Bylaw No. 98-05 are hereby rescinded.
