BYLAW NO. 2014-19


A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501



The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this Bylaw.
"ROAD" is defined as: any road allowance within the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 other than the following:
 - (a) a private road;
 - (b) a provincial highway;
 - (c) a road or highway within the following hamlets:
 - (1) The Hamlet of Frenchman Butte;
 - (2) The Hamlet of Onion Lake.
2. No buildings or structure shall be situated a distance of less than One Hundred and Fifty feet (150') from the centre line of any road unless a permit is acquired from the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
3. No building or structure shall be situated a distance of less than Three Hundred Feet (300') from an intersection of roads unless a permit is acquired from the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
4. Subject to council discretion, Public Utility buildings or structures may be situated closer to the centre line of a road. The distance will be decided by the council of the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
5. Every person who causes a building or structure to be situated in contravention of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
6. Permits issued pursuant to this bylaw must be approved by resolution of council.
7. Bylaw No. 99-05, A Bylaw Respecting the Situation of Buildings and Structures in the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, is hereby repealed.




