R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 Council is pleased to announce 2017 Recreation and Culture Funding is now available. The R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 Council passed motion 2017-04-27-025 on April 27, 2017 with reference to allocations for 2017 Recreation and Culture Funding.

2017 Historical Signage received an allocation of \$5,000.00. The R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 Council will review written submissions. Submissions should be in letter format and include all relevant information with regards to the signage required. All approved signage will be purchased and installed by the R.M. as per the signage standards set by the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 Council.

2017 Event Hosting received an allocation of \$20,000.00 with a **maximum allocation amount of \$750.00 per event per organization**. The Event must be open to the public. The Event Application (Form A) can be submitted anytime from January to October 31, 2017. If your event is scheduled to take place after October 31, 2017 you must apply before October 31, 2017. If your Application is approved you will be notified and the Event Payment Claim (Form B) will be sent to you. The Event Payment Claim (Form B) and all supporting documentation must be submitted no later than December 31 for the year in which the event was hosted. Please note that alcohol and GST are not eligible expenses.

2017 Community Capital Projects received an allocation of \$30,000.00 with a **maximum allocation amount of \$5,000.00 per project per organization**. This grant is paid at 50 cents on the dollar up to the grant maximum (e.g. in order to receive the maximum grant amount of \$5,000.00 the approved project must have valid expenses in excess of \$10,000.00 excluding GST). The Community Capital Grant Application (Form A) must be submitted between May 01 and June 30, 2017, regardless of when the project is taking place in 2017. If your Application is approved you will be notified and the Capital Payment Claim (Form B) will be sent to you. The Capital Payment Claim (Form B) and all supporting documentation must be submitted no later than December 31 for the year in which the project was completed.

Please note the following:

- A Quorum of Council is required to approve applications for all Recreational and Cultural Funding.
- Events, Projects and Historical Sites must be located within the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501, the Hamlet of Frenchman Butte, the Village of Paradise Hill or the Town of St. Walburg.
- Please refer the Historical Signage Grant Policy #700-01 or the Event Hosting Grant Policy #700-02 or the Community Capital Grant Policy #700-03 for further information and details.
