

BYLAW No. 5

A BYLAW to prevent the plowing and the obstructing of roads and prohibiting the driving of vehicles over sidewalks.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No.501 enacts as follows:-

- 1. No person shall plow any road or portion thereof within the limits of the municipality.
- 2. No person shall incumber or obstruct any highway, street or lane in the municipality by leaving a vehicle, building or other thing standing thereon.
- 3. No person shall cause any vehicle to be driven over any sidewalk in any hamlet in the municipality, except at a properly constructed crossing.
- 4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided by the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote and passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No.501, at Paradise Hill, in the Province of Saskatchewan, this 4th day of February, A.D.1954.
