

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL AND DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS ON LAND WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS by Section 3 of the Pest Control Act, the Minister of Agriculture may by order published in The Saskatchewan Gazette declare any animal, insect or disease that he deems likely to be destructive of or dangerous to any crops, grain, livestock or other property to be a pest for the purpose of the said Act; and

WHEREAS the said Minister has by order published in the issue of the Saskatchewan Gazette for June 17, 1957, declared grasshoppers to be a pest for the purpose of the said Act; and

WHEREAS power is vested in the Council of the Municipality by Section 12, of the Pest Control Act, to enact bylaws for the control of any pest to which such Act relates;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:

"Committee" means members appointed by the Municipality,
"Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.

"Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.

"Owner" includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the Municipality.

2. The Council shall, in each year, appoint a committee, to be known as the 'Grasshopper Control Committee' to administer this bylaw.

3. Every owner shall take the following measures for the control and destruction of grasshoppers:

- He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals on his land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the Committee, warrants such application; and

-He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals within the area lying between the centre line of the road allowance adjoining his land and the nearest boundary of the said land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application.

-He shall trap strip all of his stubble fields within the area of the municipality where he has failed to destroy all green growth early and before grasshoppers hatch.

4. This bylaw shall remain in force until repealed by bylaw of the Municipality.
