

BYLAW No. 7

A BYLAW to compel the removal of dirt, stones, filth and rubbish from public places.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No.501 enacts as follows:-

1. No person shall throw, place, deposit or leave in any street, sidewalk, highway, alley or other public place in the Municipality any dirt, stones, filth or rubbish.
2. Any person throwing, placing or depositing on any public place in the municipality any dirt, stones, filth or rubbish shall within twenty four hours after having been notified by the council, the health officer, or any municipal official acting on their behalf, remove said dirt, stones, filth or rubbish and place same where directed by the notice, and in default of so doing the council may order said removal at the expense of the person in default and the municipality may recover the expenses thereof with costs by action in any court of competent jurisdiction or in like manner as municipal taxes.
3. The payment of a fine for infraction of this bylaw shall not relieve the person in default from liability under Section 2.
4. Any person found guilty of any infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty provided by the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote, and passed by the council of The Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No.501, at Paradise Hill, in the Province of Saskatchewan, this 4th day of February, A.D.1954.


