

BYLAW NO. 79

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501 TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE IMHOFF MUSEUM AT NW 8-53-22-W3, SASKATCHEWAN (CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NO. 93B07754) AS BEING A SITE OF HISTORICAL VALUE.

WHEREAS part III of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Imhoff Museum at NW 8-53-22-W3 a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the administrator of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of historical value or interest the real property known as the Imhoff Museum at NW 8-53-22-W3 and legally described as:

"All that portion of the North West Quarter of Section 8, Township 53, Range 22, West of the Third Meridian, Saskatchewan, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Northern boundary of the quarter section 214.23 metres Westerly from the North East corner of the quarter section; thence Southerly at right angles to the Northern boundary, 152.71 metres; thence Westerly and parallel with the Northern boundary 209.09 metres; thence Northerly at right angles to the Northern boundary to a point on the Northern boundary; thence Easterly along the Northern boundary to the point of commencement." As shown on Certificate of Title No. 93B07754.

The significance of the site is as follows:

- (a) Constructed in 1918, the Imhoff Residence has the art work of Berthold Von Imhoff painted on the ceilings.
- (b) Constructed in 1922, the Imhoff Museum is the building in which Berthold Von Imhoff used as a studio to paint all of his works of art.
- (c) The walls of the studio also have actual works of the artist painted on them.
- (d) The site is a landmark in the municipality.

- 2. The administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
- 3. The administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
