

BYLAW No. 11

A BYLAW to provide for health and cleanliness.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, enacts as follows:-

1. The occupant or the owner of any land within the limits of the municipality, upon which there is any stagnant or putrid matter offensive to health, shall remove the same upon being notified to do so, and every such person who neglects to do so within two days after being notified shall be guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
2. No pile or deposit of manure or garbage and no accumulation of any offensive or nauseous substance shall be allowed on any subdivided property within the municipality; nor shall any person unload, discharge or put upon or along any railroad, street, highway or public place any manure, offal, garbage or other offensive or nauseous substance; nor shall cars or trucks loaded with or having in or upon them any such substance be allowed to stand on or along any street or highway within three hundred ~~feet~~ yards of any inhabited dwelling. All manure from stables within a hamlet where not more than three horses, cows or other animals are kept shall, between April and November of each year, be removed at least every seventh day, where over three and not more than five such animals are kept manure shall be removed every fourth day between the said dates.
3. The owner or person in possession of any animals which die within the hamlet shall, within twelve hours thereafter, cause the carcass to be removed to the nearest nuisance ground, and there dispose of same according to instructions of the health inspector.
4. No person shall throw, place, deposit or leave in any street, highway, lane, alley, or public place or square any animal or vegetable substance, dead animal, fish, shells, shavings, dirt, rubbish, excrement, filth, manure, slops, unclean or nauseous water, hay, straw, paper, ashes, cinders, soot, offal, garbage or any other article or substance whatever.
5. Any person who keeps any lot, ground or other premises in such a condition as to be offensive to the neighborhood or to any person or family, shall be liable to the penalties provided for an infraction of this bylaw.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided by the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
