

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501

BYLAW NO. 97-03

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH FEES TO BE PAID TO THE MUNICIPALITY WHEN FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
- 2. Every appellant, who files a notice of appeal to the board of revision of the municipality shall, at the time of filing the notice to appeal or at any time within 30 days after the day on which the notice of assessment was mailed, pay an appeal fee to the municipality.
- 3. The appeal fee shall be \$40.00 per assessment being appealed as listed on the notice of appeal filed with the municipality.
