

BYLAW NO. 99-02

BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 to designate a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of The Heritage Property Act authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has determined that the lands and premises known as:

Frenchman Butte Museum and consisting of the
CNR Station building and the original "Big Hill"
School building

and located at:

Frenchman Butte, Saskatchewan

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, pataeontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a. served on the owners of said property;
- b. served on the Registrar of Heritage Property;
- c. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate Land Titles Office; and,
- d. published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;


THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

Parcel X, Plan 92B02289,
Frenchman Butte, Saskatchewan
MINES AND MINERALS EXCEPTED

The reasons for the designation are as follows:

- a. The owner has requested official designation
- b. Two buildings, namely the original "Big Hill" School and the CNR Station are considered to have significant heritage value




- 2. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of Designation to be:
 - a. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office; and,
 - b. served on the owners of said property.

- 3. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.




