A BYLAW TO REGULATE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw (definitions found in Section 2(b) of The All Terrain Vehicles Act):
  - a) "all terrain vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle that:
    - i. is designed primarily for the movement of people or goods on unprepared surfaces; and
    - ii. has wheels in contact with the ground
 and includes:
    - iii. a restricted use motorcycle;
    - iv. a mini-bike, and
    - v. an all terrain cycle

All terrain vehicles are prohibited from operating on the untraveled portion of the road
• South of Pt. SW 4-54-25-W3 and North of Pt. NW 33-53-25-W3
as shown in "Schedule A" below (as provided for under Section 11 of The All Terrain Vehicles Act).

The area specified in "Schedule A" is marked by signage indicating No All Terrain Vehicles allowed (as indicated in Section 13(3) of The All Terrain Vehicles Act).
