

**R.M. OF FRENCHMAN BUTTE NO. 501**

**BYLAW NO 2016-06**

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO A CAT AND DOG FEE FOR SERVICE AGREEMENT**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The R.M of Frenchman Butte No. 501 is hereby authorized to enter into a Service Agreement with the Lloydminster and District SPCA. The Service Agreement is attached and forms a part of this bylaw, identified as "Exhibit A".
2. The Reeve and the Administrator of the R.M. of Frenchman Butte are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached Service Agreement identified as "Exhibit A".



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EXHIBIT A.

**2016 Cat & Dog Fee for Service Agreement**

Between:

The LLOYDMINSTER AND DISTRICT SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS, a society registered under the "Societies" Act in the province of Saskatchewan (hereinafter referred to as the "Society")

OF THE FIRST PART

-AND-

**RM of Frenchman Butte No. 501**, a municipal corporation with offices in **Paradise Hill** in the province of **Saskatchewan** (hereinafter referred to as the "**RM**")

OF THE SECOND PART

It is hereby agreed between the Society and the **RM** as follows:

1. Animal Care Facility

The Society agrees to act as the **RM** designated Animal Care Facility and agrees to carry out all duties specified under Bylaw and amendments there to. It is agreed that the Society shall be responsible for the release of all impounded dogs or cats to the proper owners once all fines and license fees, as determined by the **RM**, are collected.

It is further agreed that, if after completion of the agreed upon 72 hour holding period, the cat or dog has not been reclaimed by the proper owner, the **RM** shall pay the sum of **\$100** for each dog or cat that is impounded under the provisions of the Bylaw.

It is understood that the meaning of "stray dog" or "stray cat" within the context of this agreement shall mean any dog or cat that is impounded or brought to the shelter under direct authority of the **RM**.

2. Adoption of Impounded Animals

It is agreed that the society may adopt an animal that is impounded from the **RM** under our Bylaw's in accordance with the rules and procedures of their own Bylaws and Constitution after the 3-day mandatory holding period has expired.

Term of Agreement

It is further agreed that the term of this agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year from the first day of March, 2016 and shall be automatically renewed each year unless either party gives notice in writing of at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of term that they do not wish to renew this agreement. Such notice must be given in writing and sent by standard mail to the other party's last known address.




