**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
THE TOWN OF ST. WALBURG TO ALLOW FOR A SIGNING CORRIDOR.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

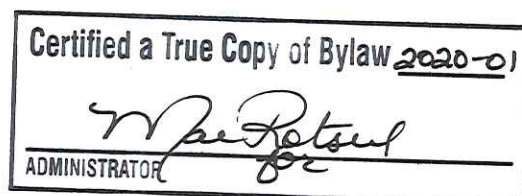
1. The R.M of Frenchman Butte No. 501 is hereby authorized to enter into Partnership Agreement with the Town of St. Walburg to establish a signing corridor for the purpose of promoting tourism and economic development, attached hereto and forming a part of this bylaw, and identified as "Exhibit A".
2. The Reeve and the Chief Administrative Officer of the R.M. of Frenchman Butte are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as "Exhibit A".

SCHEDULE "A" TO BYLAW 2019-15
PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

Town of St. Walburg

HEREINAFTER called "The Town"

AND:

Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte #501
PO Box 180
Paradise Hill, SK S0M 2G0
HEREINAFTER called "The RM"

WHEREAS, the Town and the RM wish to establish a signing corridor for the purpose of promoting tourism and economic development:

The parties hereby agree to the following:

1. A signing corridor has been established at the following locations:
 - a. Adjacent to Provincial Highway No. 26 extending for five (5) meters in a generally easterly direction from the south boundary line of the southwest quarter in Section 33, Township 53, Range 22, West of the 3rd Meridian to the north boundary line of the same quarter, a total distance of 805 meters; and
 - b. Adjacent to Provincial Highway No. 26 extending for five (5) meters in a generally northwesterly direction from a point 420 meters north of the west boundary line of the northeast quarter in Section 4, Township 54, Range 22, West of the 3rd Meridian to the west boundary line of the southwest quarter in Section 10, Township 54, Range 22, West of the 3rd Meridian, a total distance of 772 meters.
2. The Town shall act as Administrator of the sign corridor.
3. As Administrator of the sign corridor, the Town shall be responsible for approving all signs prior to installation, ensuring that all signs meet with standards, as set by the Department of Highways, for placement of signs alongside provincial highways.
4. All signs shall adhere to guidelines designed to create an aesthetically pleasing sign and sign corridor. These guidelines shall be determined by the Administrator.
