1. PURPOSE:

To establish appropriate guidelines and a consistent policy for Election and Referendum Officials of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501. To ensure Election and Referendum Officials are appropriately remunerated.

2. DEFINITIONS:

2.1 Council:

Means Council for the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.

2.2 Election Officials:

Means appointed Returning Officer, Deputy Returning Officers and Polling Clerks for the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.

2.1 Remuneration:

Means the per diem compensation paid to Election Officials for the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.

3.0 SCOPE:

3.1 To set remuneration schedule for any Election or Referendum polling station staff, in accordance with Section 160.13 (1) (c).

4.0 POLICY:

It is the policy of the Rural Municipality to:

5.0 SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS (if applicable)

5.1 Council will appoint the Returning Officer and all other Election Officials will be appointed by the Returning Officer.

6.0 EXCEPTIONS – (if applicable)

6.1 Where Municipal Staff perform the duties of an Election Official, the employee shall be paid their regular wage rate.



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7.0 REPEALING:

All Appendices attached to this policy may be amended from time to time based on operational need.

This policy shall be administered and interpreted by the CAO; however, this policy cannot be amended without Council approval.

This policy replaces all previous policies and resolutions that have been passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 with respect to the application of any and all parts of this policy and the terms and conditions contained herein.

This policy shall come into force and take effect on March 7, 2018 shall continue in full force and effect until repealed or replaced by subsequent resolution of Council.
