1. PURPOSE:

The Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 ("the RM") requires this policy to direct the payment for land impacted by back-sloping adjacent to Municipal road projects.

2. DEFINITIONS:

2.1 Back-sloping

Means areas where soil material is cut away from a hill in order to accommodate road construction, maintenance activities, or other activities of the RM resulting in the need for land to be back-sloped. Often sloped by varying degrees, depending on bank composition and slope stability.

2.2 Council:

Means Council for the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501.

3.0 SCOPE:

This policy shall be applied whenever road construction, maintenance activities, or other activities of the RM resulting in the need for land to be back-sloped.

4.0 POLICY:

Payment for back-sloping is established as follows:

- If the R.M. back-slopes beyond the newly established right of way, the payment is to be calculated using the same formula as is used for the Sale of Land for Right of Way Policy 300-05 (per acre).
- Landowner is entitled to any crop loss due to back-sloping and shall be compensated as per Crop Loss Compensation Policy 300-03.
- Payment for back-sloping compensation and crop loss on back-sloping will be paid upon completion of construction project and final survey by RM surveyor or engineer.

5.0 SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: As listed above in 4.0.

6.0 EXCEPTIONS: None

7.0 RESPONSIBILITY/INTERPRETATION/REPEALING:

This policy shall be administered and interpreted by the Administrator; however, this policy cannot be amended without Council approval.

This policy replaces all previous policies and resolutions that have been passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 with respect to the application of any and all parts of this policy and the terms and conditions contained herein.

This policy shall come into force and take effect on April 6, 2018 shall continue in full force and effect until repealed or replaced by subsequent resolution of Council.

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
