## 1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is for the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 Council to create Policy for the replacement of fence removed due to road construction and/or brushing of road allowances.

## 2. DEFINITIONS:

- 2.1 **CAO:** Means the Chief Administrative Officer of the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
- 2.2 **Council:** Means Council for the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501.
- 2.3 **Municipality:** Shall mean the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No 501.
- 2.4 **Land owner:** Shall mean the person or persons whose name the property is titled.

## 3. SCOPE:

To establish policy by which fence removed for the purposes of construction and/or brushing is replaced.

## 4. POLICY:

This policy establishes the compensation rates for landowners to replace an existing fence after the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 road construction or brushing project is completed.

## 5. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The municipality shall be responsible for the replacement of fence removed for the purposes of road construction and/or brushing of road allowances.

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Fence Replacement Policy

2. The fence shall be same type of fence as the one removed. (barbwire, electric, and page wire, etc.).
3. If the landowner wishes to add additional wires, posts or larger posts beyond those found on the existing fence, the landowner is responsible for the additional labour and materials costs.

**6.0 EXCEPTIONS –**

1. If land-owner does not wish to replace fence at same location from which it was removed the municipality will stage any salvageable wire and posts on land-owners property. Land-owner is responsible to dispose of.

**7.0 RESPONSIBILITY/INTERPRETATION/REPEALING:**

All Appendices attached to this policy may be amended from time to time based on operational need.

This policy shall be administered and interpreted by the CAO; however, this policy cannot be amended without Council approval.

This policy repeals and rescinds all previous policies and resolutions that have been passed by the Council with respect to the application of any and all parts of this policy and the terms and conditions contained herein.

This policy shall come into force and take effect on January 24, 2018 and shall continue in full force and effect until repealed or amended by subsequent resolution of Council.
