



Public Works Plow and Sanding Truck Tender 2022E

INFORMATION FOR SUPPLIERS

1. Submission of Tenders

- **Only emailed submissions will be accepted.** Please include **PLOW AND SANDING TRUCK TENDER** in your email heading.
- Completed tenders must be received **before 2:00 p.m. on September 26, 2022.**
- Bids will not be opened publicly.

 - Tenders received later than the time specified will not be accepted regardless of the circumstances.
 - **The lowest priced tender or any tender not necessarily accepted.**
- A decision will be made by resolution of Municipal Council at meeting held on September 28, 2022.

2. Tender Minimum Product Specifications and Requirements

One Plow and Sanding Truck must be equipped with the minimum following Specifications:

1. Engine
 - Minimum 475 horsepower engine – 1600 RPM at 105 km/hr
2. Transmission
 - Automatic - capable of pulling tridem pup trailer
3. Tires/Rims
 - 425/65R22.5 20 Front Tires with aluminum rims or similar
 - 11R24.5 Rear Tires with aluminum rims
4. Other Specifications
 - Tandem Truck must come equipped PUP Ready
 - Back Up Alarm
 - LED Beacon Lights – Blue and Amber
 - Four Way Locks
 - 46,000 lb Tandem Rear Axles
 - 20,000 lb Front Axle, Spring Build up Right hand for wing application or similar to carry front mount plow
 - Mud Flaps
 - Blue Tooth Capability
 - 400 litre minimum sized aluminum fuel tanks
 - Air Ride Suspension
 - Tandem axle day cab
 - Front left side sand discharge
 - Front frame extension 20" for snow plow mount
 - Winter package
 - 12 foot dual direction front mount plow
 - 11 foot right side mid mount wing

- 10 yard left front spinner sand box
- Rear strobe beacon or flashing lights on sander or at top box corners for winter plowing/sanding use.
- Under Coated Frame
- Aluminum Air Tanks
- Heated Windshield
- Motor Skid Plate
- Cab undercoat

3. Trade-in Information

4. Right to Accept or Reject Tenders

The tender shall be based upon the whole of the Specifications without reservations. Please list all standard and optional equipment as well as any other pertinent information needed for council to make a fair comparison. Please complete and submit the *Tender Cover Page*.

The lowest priced tender or any tender not necessarily accepted.

Tenders which are incomplete, conditional, obscure or which do not meet the requirements shall be rejected. Erasures/alterations must be initialled by the tenderer.

Provincial Sales Tax and G.S.T. applicable shall be entered in separately from unit prices.

5. Unacceptable or Unbalanced Tenders

Each item in the tender shall be a reasonable price for such item. Under no circumstance will an unbalanced tender be considered. The R.M of Frenchman Butte No. 501 will be the sole judge of such matters and should any tender be considered unbalanced it will be rejected.

6. Interpretation of Documents

If a prospective tenderer is in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of the specifications, documents or find omissions or errors they must notify the Public Works Supervisor – Dan Fedirko @ 306-344-7973. If an addendum or change is deemed necessary, the changes will be posted on the RM website and on SaskTenders.ca.

7. Increase in Quote

No claim for increase in rates on unit prices or other prices will be entertained. Any and all charges not set out in the tender, must be clearly indicated on the agreement of sale.

8. Payments

Payment will be issued at the first meeting of Council (Council meets two times per month) following the delivery of the truck to the R.M. yard and upon inspection by the Public Works Supervisor.

9. Execution of Contract

Failure by the successful bidder to meet the above requirements will entitle the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 to cancel the purchase. The R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 may then elect to award the contract to another bidder or take such action as they choose.

10. Presentations

Sales representatives must address all sales presentations and trade in viewing to the Public Works Supervisor prior to tender closing date. The Municipality is asking for your best price and all submitted information and prices at the tender opening is the only price being accepted.
