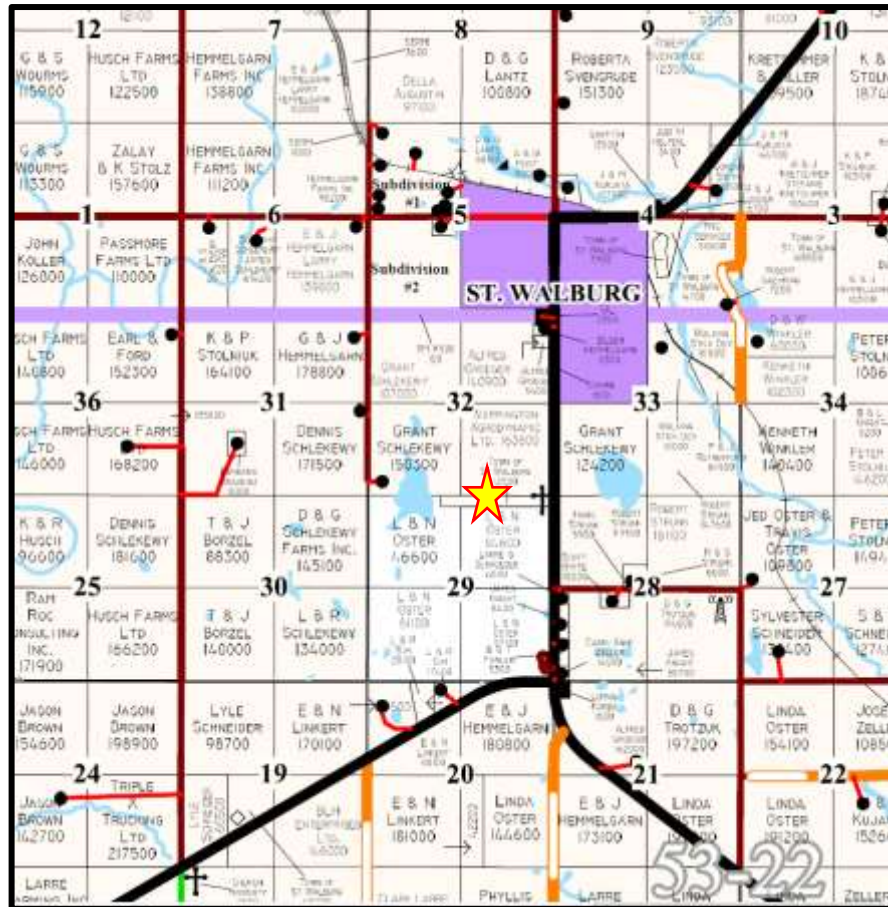

- The bid evaluation process will be conducted at the discretion of the RM. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the price to complete the work is not the only criterion to be used by the RM in awarding the contract.
- No bidder shall have any claim for any compensation of any kind whatsoever, as a result of submitting a proposal. When submitting a proposal, each proponent shall be deemed to have agreed it has no claim.
- The lowest proposal or any proposal will not necessarily be accepted.
- Any questions about the project should be asked & answered at the site meeting. If there are questions remaining after that date, they must be emailed to rm501pwm@sasktel.net. Questions and answers will then be forwarded to all potential bidders.
- Assessment criteria will be based 70% on price, 30% on references.

SITE MEETING

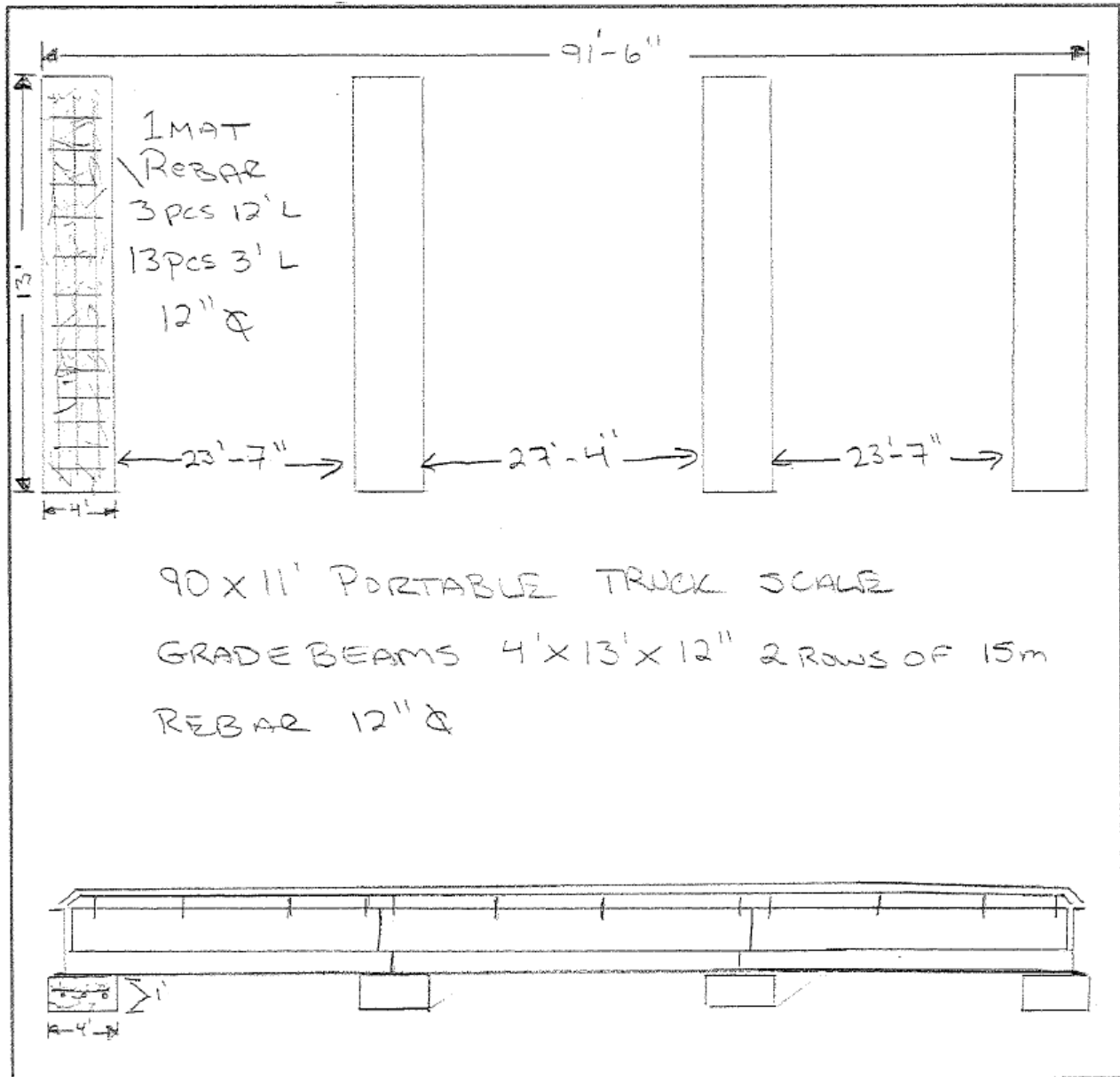

Specifics of concrete work:

- The scale is 90 feet x 11 feet and requires a concrete foundation consisting of four separate grade beams, each 4' x 13' x 1' in size with rebar supports. Please see plans on the following page.

- The contractor is responsible for obtaining all line locates.
- The contractor must supply all forms and rebar as listed in sketch on previous page.
- **Before pouring cement, rebar must be inspected by the scale committee.** Call Ronald Gory at 306-248-7758 to arrange an inspection.
- The RM will remove the topsoil and roughly level the site.
- The RM will supply base gravel under the beams, and gravel to fill between the newly built road and the scale edges.
- Construction must be completed between **May 14th and July 31st, 2020, provided the road work has been completed.**
- A single payment will be made at the first Council meeting following the successful completion of the project.
- Any contractor who has not maintained a permanent place of business in Saskatchewan for the twelve months immediately preceding the date of the work shall make arrangements satisfactory to the Provincial Treasurer to ensure compliance with The Provincial Sales Tax Act. No final payment will be paid until the Rural Municipality has certificates from the Provincial Treasurer that the contractor has paid the PST.
- The Contractor will be required to furnish all necessary equipment, tools, fuel, supplies, and labour required to complete the work set out in the document, unless otherwise stated.
